	<b>IT'S ALL IN THE NUMBERS</b> <b>Speed</b> Speed is the ability of a disc to cut through the air. Speed ratings are from 1 to 12. Discs with higher numbers are faster. Lower numbers offer better distance control. <b>Turn - High Speed Turn</b> The tendency of a disc to bank right (for RHBH* throwers) early in the flight. A disc rated +1 is most resistant to turn over. A disc rated -4 will turn the easiest. <b>Turn - Low Speed Turn</b> A higher glide number means the disc can ride the air better. New players should try discs with more glide. A disc rated 6 has the most glide. Go for low glide when throwing into headwind. <b>Fade - Low Speed Fade</b> All discs tail off in the same direction (left for RHBH* shots), but some will "hook" harder than others. A disc rated zero will finish the straightest while a 5 will hook the hardest.	<b>Birdie</b> Our "Go for it" putter. Straight but stops quick. 1 2 0 0  DX	<b>Polecat</b> A slow, straight putter. All around short range disc. 1 3 0 0  DX	<b>Sonic</b> A golf disc that feels like a catch disc. 1 2 -4 0  DX, Star	Putt & Approach
