	IT'S ALL IN THE NUMBERS Speed Speed is the ability of a disc to cut through the air. Speed ratings are from 1 to 12. Discs with higher numbers are faster. Lower numbers offer better distance control. Turn - High Speed Turn The tendency of a disc to bank right (for RHBH* throwers) early in the flight. A disc rated +1 is most resistant to turn over. A disc rated -4 will turn the easiest. Turn - Low Speed Turn A higher glide number means the disc can ride the air better. New players should try discs with more glide. A disc rated 6 has the most glide. Go for low glide when throwing into headwind. Fade - Low Speed Fade All discs tail off in the same direction (left for RHBH* shots), but some will "hook" harder than others. A disc rated zero will finish the straightest while a 5 will hook the hardest.	Birdie Our "Go for it" putter. Straight but stops quick. 1 2 0 0  DX	Polecat A slow, straight putter. Distance & Flight Comparison
Thrown properly these discs will fly as shown.

Each disc has a unique flight path. These flight paths represent a disc thrown flat and far by an advanced level player. Righty backhand or lefty sidearm is shown.
Each flight path displays the beginning of the flight at the bottom and the finish at the top. Higher speed discs have longer flight paths shown than lower speed discs even though the flight paths may look the same.

* RightHand Back Hand throws
